#### ► A NETWORK of local authorities

A national association (non-profit organisation under the 1901 Association Law), the Grands Sites de France Network brings together local authorities in charge of Grands Sites de France management. It gathers sites that have been awarded the Grand Site de France label and others in the planning stage.
