The Grand Site de France label is granted by the Minister of Ecology. It is recorded in the French Environmental Code and is awarded for a duration of 6 years renewable. The label distinguishes management of a landscape that guarantees its long-term protection.



Grands Sites de France are landscape conservation areas protected by law, well-known to everyone for their beauty.




